- 4. In a culture where the institution of marriage is in decline and divorce is commonplace, Paul's guidance is crucial.
- 5. Marriage and family are the bedrock of any society.
- 6. It should not be a surprise that marriage and family are under attack.
- 7. Paul can teach us to strengthen our homes.
