- 2. Seeking an Answer to a Troubling Question
 - Eternal life...His hope and goal...question is how to get there?
 - Human goodness through obedience to God? Something else?
- 3. A Note About Money I Timothy 6:10
 - Hope: Defined by Websters as: Desire accompanied by expectation of fulfillment.
 - Faith: Defined by Webster's: A deep-seated trust or belief, usually to a God or religious system.

- Hebrews 11:1, "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen."
- Trust: Webster's again "Assured reliance on the character, strength, or truth of someone or something...a basis of reliance, faith or hope."
- Hope is an emotional or desire focus. Faith is an intellectual focus that leads to an act of one's will. Trust is a focus to action...based on faith and/or hope.
- 4. What is the focus of your heart? What do you place your hope, faith and trust in?
