Introduction: Paul has been explaining spiritual gifts beginning in chapter 12. This morning, we will complete this section.

- 1. Last week, as Paul dealt with the abuse in Corinth, he shared two important goals for the worship service.
 - Edification (Spiritual Growth)
 - Clarity (Understanding The Truth)
- 2. This is not the sole purpose of worship, in fact the primary focus on worship is honoring God.
- 3. When you consider the benefit from the worshippers' perspective, clarity and edification are essential.
- 4. Because that is true, Paul instructs the Corinthians on the best way to order their worship services.
- I. Emphasize Prophecy
 - A. Because Of The Purpose Of Tonques
 - B. Because Of The Purpose Of Prophecy
- II. Emphasize Edification
 - A. Follow God's Guidelines
 - B. Practice Humility
 - C. Maintain Order

Conclusion: Based on Paul's instruction, we have the opportunity to evaluate our worship service.

- 1. We'll start with worship from God's perspective.
- 2. The word "worship" comes from the old English "worthship".
 - Does your worship reflect God's value and worth?
- 3. From a worshipper's perspective, Paul was clear, spiritual growth was the focus.
- 4. That requires the Word to be presented clearly, but it also requires active, engaged listening.
- 5. As we engage God's Word, the goal is to know what it says, what it means, and how it applies to our lives today.
- 6. So that we can live the truth.
 - Are you an active listener?
 - Are you a doer of the Word?
