



Some wise men were called Magi. They came to Jerusalem looking for a special baby.





The wise men followed a new star that had appeared bright in the sky.

The Magi opened their treasures and presented baby Jesus with gifts. What did they bring?








After Jesus was born in Bethlehem, certain wise men called Magi came from the east to Jerusalem. What did they ask?

Help the Magi find their way from the east to Jerusalem. Read their words along the way.


