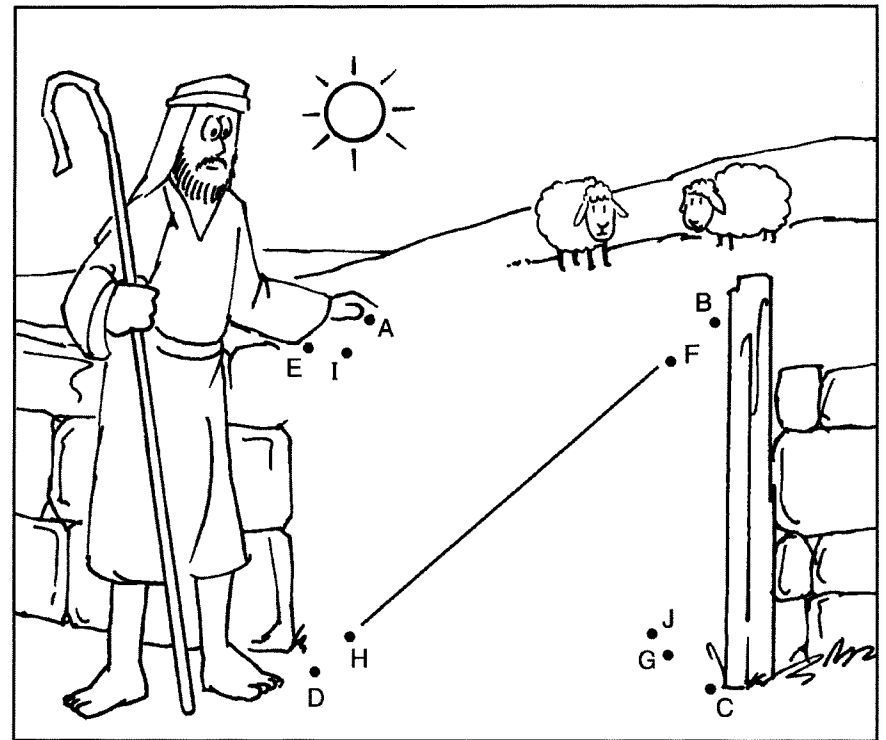

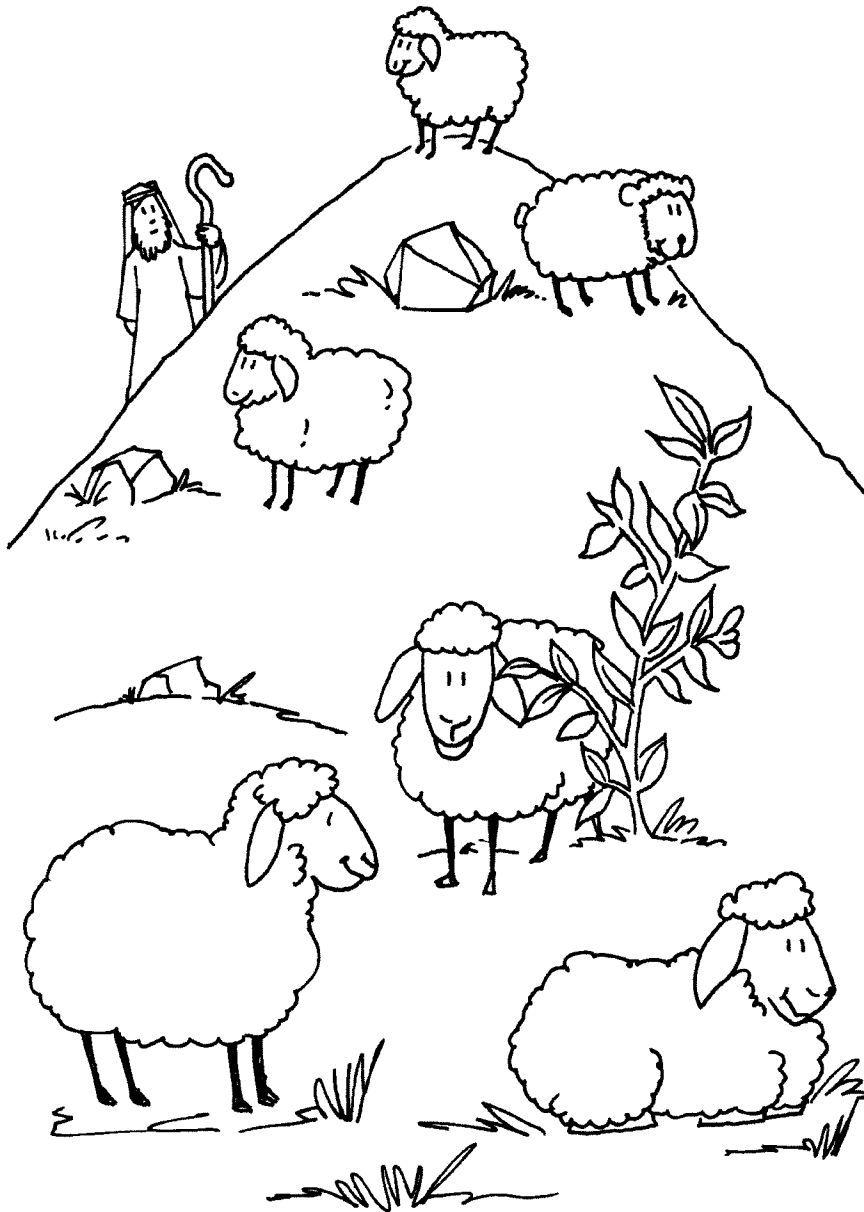
The shepherd enters by the gate.

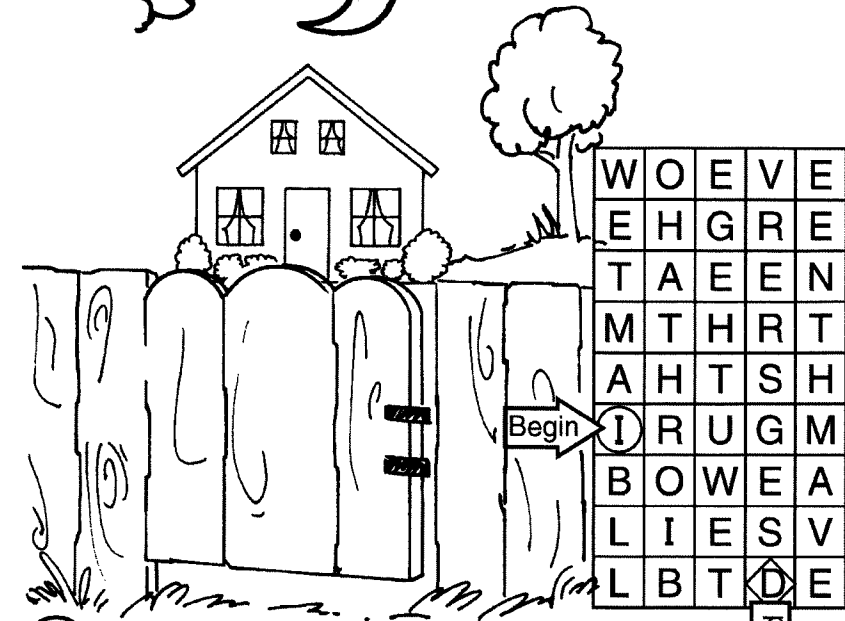

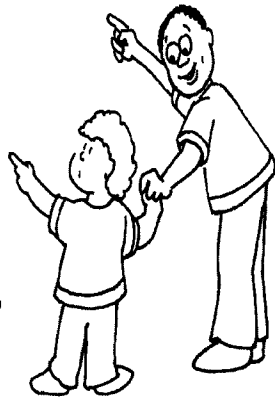
