Introduction: In John 13-17, Jesus is preparing the disciples for their future.

1. Some of the preparation was simply explaining what was about to happen, some was simply encouragement, the rest was focused on God's provision that would enable them to succeed.
2. Today we will focus on peace. It is an integral part of this preparation.
3. Peace can be defined as the wellbeing that comes from God.
 - It includes the idea of rest, security, freedom from hostility, order as opposed to disorder, harmony, wholeness or completion.
4. The disciples were on the threshold of a very scary future, but in Christ they could experience peace.
5. That same peace is available to us today.
