Exodus 3:1-14, John 15:5

Introduction: We are in the midst of a series focused on moving away from a self-centered life to a God-centered life.

1. So far, we have recognized God is at work all around us.
 - Therefore, we don't need to ask, "What can I do for God today?"
 - Instead, we can simply ask "Where are you at work today, and how do you want me to join you?"
 - As we learned last week, God desires a personal, ongoing love relationship with us.
2. This morning, we'll focus on His invitation to join Him in His ongoing work.
 - An invitation rooted in our relationship with Him.
 - An invitation rooted in spiritual reality.
3. We see in the life of Moses exactly how this invitation works.
